Traffic Pattern Changes and Lane Closures on New Jersey Avenue NW Begin September 3

(Washington, DC) - The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises motorists to expect lane closures, parking restrictions and traffic pattern changes on New Jersey Avenue NW between H Street NW and N Street NW beginning on or about September 3, 2019, weather permitting.

All construction activity will take place between 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday behind traffic barriers. Lane closures are expected to run from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Some night work may be required. This work is a part of the Safety Improvements on New Jersey Avenue NW Project, and is required for curb, gutter, sidewalk and driveway reconstruction.

Traffic controls will be in place to guide motorists through the work zone safely. Motorists should expect delays due to the lane closures. All roadway users are advised to stay alert and be observant of signage and road work crews while traveling in this area.

Curbside parking may also be restricted while work is underway. Emergency No Parking signs will be posted a minimum of 72 hours before the start of construction. Detours will be in place while sidewalk repair is in progress. Signage and protective barriers will be used to maintain pedestrian safety.
